



Max, a 15-year-old pony gelding, presented for a wellness exam on 8/13/2026. Upon presentation, Max was BAR with a BCS of 6/9.

- Eyes: clear, free of debris/irritation, mild mucoid discharge bilaterally
- Ears: no discharge present externally, no obvious abnormalities present
- Oral exam: unremarkable, no sharp points palpable externally, lateral excursion correct and even. Full sedated oral exam not performed at this visit.
- Mucous Membranes: pink and moist
- Heart and lungs: auscultate clear, no murmurs
- Integument: clean, free of debris
- Abdomen: GI sounds present in all four quadrants, no palpable surgery scar, no swelling or edema along underbelly or sheath
- Digital Pulses present and within normal limits in all four limbs, no palpable pain or swelling along distal limbs in any limb, slightly long in the toe on all four feet but otherwise healthy feet
- Ambulates even and well at the walk, did not evaluate at the trot. Full lameness exam not performed at this visit
- Temperature: 99.1F

Overall, Max appears apparently healthy.
